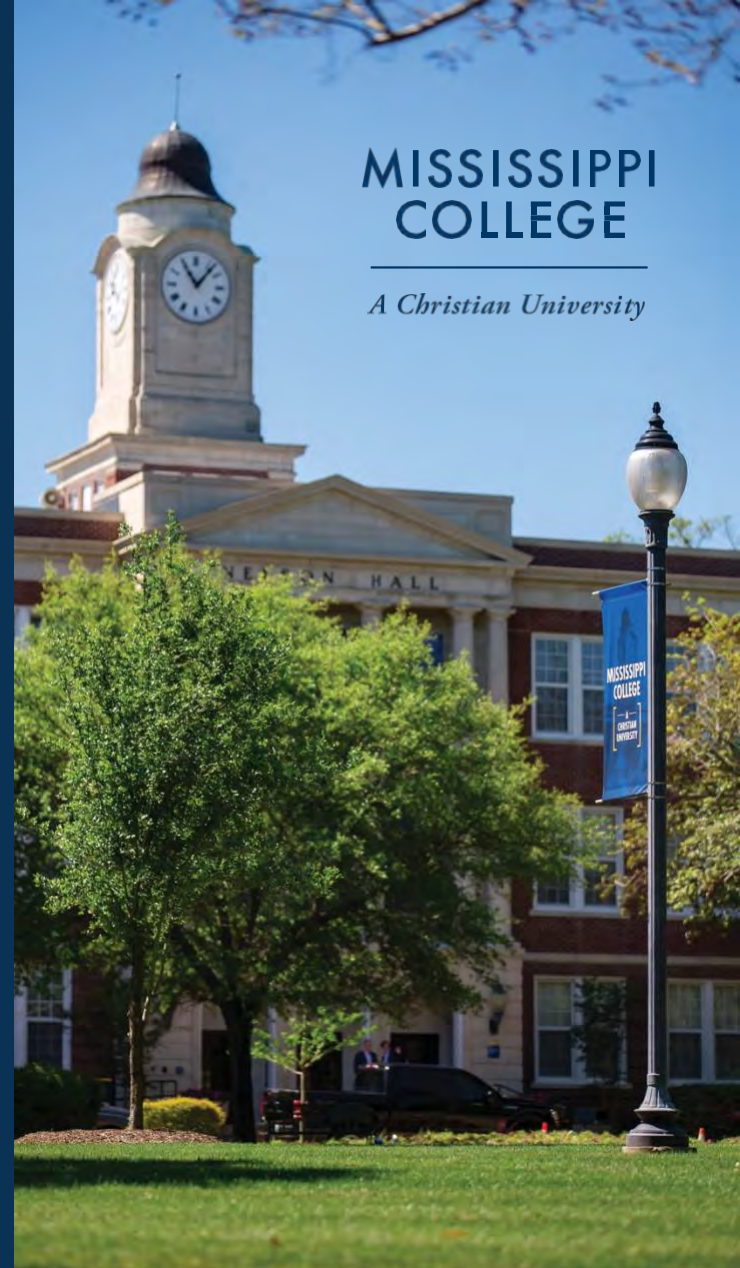

TUITION & SCHOLARSHIPS

Mississippi College is ranked as one of the BEST VALUE universities in the US because of its low tuition, affordable cost of living, and high-quality instruction. The **tuition and fees for two (2) academic semesters for undergraduate and graduate** are as follows:

All first-year undergraduate students receive a \$2,000 scholarship for the first 2 semesters with GPA of 2.5 or above.

Students with ACT/SAT scores may be eligible for scholarships. After the first year, undergraduates can apply for merit-based scholarships.

All first-year graduate students receive a \$1,500 scholarship per semester with GPA of 3.0 or above; \$2,000 is awarded to straight-A students the following semester.

Mississippi College is a premier private university famous for its commitment to academic excellence and is consistently ranked as one of the best medium private universities in the region. MC is accredited by the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools (SACS). MC has the authority to grant Bachelor, Masters, PhD, EdD, and JD degrees. To assist students whose English language skills are still developing, MC also hosts an Intensive English Program (IEP) that is approved by AAIEP/EnglishUSA.
